Winemaker's Notes:	Fragrant ripe cling peach and guava, with freshly cut Golden Delicious apple and just a touch of citrus blossom. This is a deliciously mouth-watering, lively & zesty, easy-drinking Chenin is perfect for long balmy afternoons.
Style:	Fruity, yet dry
Cultivar:	100% Chenin Blanc
Tons per hectare:	6-7
Age of vine:	14 years
Soil:	Shale
Trellising:	Trellised
Irrigation:	No irrigation
Degree balling at harvest:	Early morning, hand harvested at 22°C
Vinification:	Fermented in a stainless steel tank at 11°C
Maturation potential:	Enjoy now
Food suggestions:	Complete on its own, or would be perfect with Crayfish off the braai (just lemon and salt), smoked chicken salad, or try it with grilled Snoek with freshly buttered roosterkoek and apricot jam. The wine is light and crisp to compliment the oily, salty game fish, but with enough sweet fruit to offset the savoury dish in cahoots with the apricot jam.
